Wow. Thank you so much for the Romine information. I have spent a lot of time at the Mormon library in West L.A., but had pretty much come to a grinding halt before your e-mail. Sources on the west coast are not always very good. The internet is changing everything in the never-ending genealogy searches!

I have this all neat and tidy in Reunion program, but have not yet figured out how to cut and paste it into e-mail, so here is an untidy version of my Romine line:

Peter Romine died 1788, Loudoun Co. Virginia (m. to Abigail)

Peter Romine Junior b. circa 1740, Loudoun County, Va.

Peter Romine b. circa 1816, State of Virginia d. about 1860-1870 in Hopkins County or Hunt County, Texas m. Nancy Romine (b. 1812, d. 1860-1870)

John Wesley Romine b. 16 May 1841 Washington County, Indiana. Married 2 July 1868 to Susan Ellen Pinnell Romine (of Crawford County, Missouri) d. 22 May, 1900 in Bosque County, Texas

Charles Romine, sheriff of Bosque County during the early part of the century, b. 15 Feb 1870 in Kingston, Hunt County, Texas m. 14 Nov. 1898 to Mary Ida Diltz (of Rainey's Creek, Coreye County, Texas). Died 11 Nov 1947 in Valley Mills, Texas

Dr. Charles Romine, b. 18 Aug 1912 in Bosque County, Texas m. Madonna Trail (of Forney, Texas) d. 29 March 1997 in McAllen, Texas

Rebecca Romine Bowen b. 17 Jan, 1947 Big Spring, Texas (that's me)

My documentation before John Wesley Romine is pretty sketchy--except for the Peter Romine who died in 1788 in Loudoun County. I have a copy of his will. Will be glad to contribute my research to anyone interested. Am most interested in finding out how the family got into Virginia and where they came from. I have a feeling it is the Dutch in New Jersey, but have never been able to prove a direct connection.

Again, thank you. You have given me a good new start on dusty old research that had gone no-where.
