Harrison, Polly, Daniel, Jefferson, Thaddeus my g grandfather, Ruth Ann, Elias Pembrook, Bartlett, Lafayette, Charles, Jasper J., Desta Evaline, and Harry Romine.

"Family Tradition... "My cousin in West Virginia dug up a Puzzling piece of information and sent it to me. He said the old Romines were not Romines at all, but O'Heads. The story goes that the O'Heads (Irish) shared the same boat from Holland with a Dutchman Named Romine. The O'Heads had a large family. The O'Heads became ill with "fever" and died before they reached America. The Dutchman took the orphaned children and raised them as his own. I also recall this story from my father when I was quite young. It does seem to be sensible, especially after I've combed Mrs. McDonnel's book"

(The Letter from Denise Etling, Nov.12, 1974...g.g.dau. of Jefferson) The cousin was Thaddeus Lafayette Romine, son of Charles and Mary Ellen. Denise calls him "Lash."

The tradition repeated by the daughter of Desta: When Elias was getting to the age of 18 or 19, he asked his father for a suit. or some better clothes; he wanted to associate with other young people. When his father refused him the clothes, Elias said he would leave home and make it on his own. His father told him he had better stay and work for him until he was 21. If he didn't, his father said that he would never tell him who he really was. Elias seems to have left.
