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Andersonville Prison John Romine

John Romine died of starvation in the Andersonville Prison. He was a private in Co H 75th Reg OVI who enlisted on Dec 3, 1861, captured at Gainsville, Va on Aug 17, 1864 and died on October 22, 1864. He is listed on page 147 of the campfire book at the Meigs Co. Museum. John had lived at Langsville, Rutland and Harrisonville. John married Sarah Terry in 1839 and they had nine children. At the time of John's death, Sarah and five children under the age of sixteen were living in Harrisonville, Oh. Sarah received a pension of \$8.00 a month. The civil war monument at Robinson Cem lists his name.

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
