On August 19, 1800 he went with his father John Romine to register for the tax list, in Lexington, the county seat of Fayette. His fathers name had appeared on the list several years prior to 1800. Do to the fact that was Andrew's first time to register it indicates he had turned 21 years of age that year. His first marriage was to Lucienda Price. They had two children, they were Lucinda and Thomas Price (Berry T. Romine's father). Their (Mother) Lucienda is buried in the Long Riddle Cemetery near Shelbyville, Kentucky. Andrew's second wife's name was Sarah (last name unknown). They had two children Docia and Peter. The family migrated to Missouri. Soon after the war of 1812. At that time the United States Government appropriated two million acres for homesteading between the St. Francois and Arkansas rivers, apparently they came to Missouri to homestead. They settled in Washington County, which is located in the homestead area. In the Washington County Records his Will was found, following is a copy. Romine, Andrew, nuncupative (oral) Will, 27th February 1819. *John Horine and Elizabeth Zeneau were called to witness the Will of the deceased in his last sickness, at his habitation in Washington County where he resided ten days previous to his death. Wife Sarah Romine, all estate for the support of my four children. Recorded 24 April 1819 Book #1, Page 11 & 12 Their four children: Lucinda Thomas Price Docia Peter Lucinda Romine Married Daniel Eastwood on July 2, 1818 By: John Horine in Washington County, MO NOTE: John Horine also witnessed Andrew Romine's Will. Thomas Price Romine "Father of Berry T. Romine" page 26 Docia Romine Born in Kentucky. Married George McFry, born in South Carolina. Living in Big River Township Jefferson County, Missouri. Both came to Missouri at an early age. They had eight children. The seventh was George W. McFry, born 1843. He was the sheriff of Jefferson County during the 1870's.
