Could have been on his own by the time the 1850 census was taken. After the 1850 Census no trace of Peter Romine can be found, in Missouri. The first court house in Jefferson County, Missouri was located in Herculaneum. It was destroyed by fire, prior to 1829 when the county seat was relocated to Hillsbourough, Missouri. Steelville the County Seat of Crawford County, Missouri. The first records were destroyed by flood. This happened frequently to the old courthouses. THOMAS PRICE ROMINE'S MATERNAL GRANDPARENTS "THOMAS PRICE AND HIS FAMILY" Copied from a book Written by: Reverend John E. Cox Titled: "Thomas Price & His Descendants" We know that in 1790 Thomas had a wife and five children. This is stated in his petition of the assembly. There may have been children who died. The name of wife is unknown, but a good probability it was ALVERSON. We know one son was John Alverson Price. He was born in Kentucky, and when he was accidentally killed on May 13, 1867 it was said that he was 74 years old. Following is the record of Thomas Price's children. Edmund-born in Virginia-1772 Married in 1793 Lucinda -born in Virginia-1774 Married in 1797 William -born in Virginia-1777 Married Elizabeth Eaton about 1802-03 A son born in Virginia (Name not known) Jesse -born in Virginia-1786 Married Lynchia Preston 1807 John A. -born in Kentucky-1793 Married, twice. First wife was Anna Anderson Second wife Patsy Benson Edmund moved down the river about Cattlettsburg, and went west and all trace of him lost. The daughter Lucienda, married Andrew Romine and died at an early age. Jesse is the only son that remained in eastern Kentucky. Jesse Price, became a very influential man in eastern Kentucky. He was a deacon in the Baptist Church and several of his sons were Baptist preachers. His wife was a Preston, one of the finest old families in Virginia. She was an educated woman and looked after the education of her children; Jesse and his wife had 13 children, eight of them being boys, the oldest son was Reverend George Washington Price. I want to mention one characteristic of the family, which crops out in both the western and eastern Kentucky branches: Thomas Price lived to be 90 years old and upward. Jesse lived to be 92; Reverend George W. was 80 at death, Zacharia was 85, William Jr., 85, David B. 94 and others lived to a good old age. "end of quote" Thomas Price Romine, must have had the Price genes, he lived to the age of 86 years and 6 days, which was very unusual during his time. Andrew Romine was married twice. The oldest children Lucinda and Thomas Price, from the first marriage. And Docia and Peter from the second marriage. Peter was 10 years younger than Thomas Price. Docia was two older than Peter. Romine born 1863 By 1984 there were no Romine's living in Howell County. However there were several of Thomas Romine's descendants living in the area. On the following pages is what can be found about each of Thomas Price Romine's children. Starting with James F. Romine through Laura J. Romine, following the Elizabeth Romine family census. (Page 37) In all the research done on the Romine Genealogy no clue was found why Berry Romine was named Berry. His Father, Uncle, and all his brothers had names of the Apostles. NOTE: Thomas Price Romine and his 3rd wife Mary Ann are buried in the Mount Zion Cemetery, near Moody, Missouri. Given under my hand, this 21 day of February 1848, John Jones, J.P. 1850 Census Franklin County This just has the information on the ex-wife, then it gives the petition for divorce where Thomas Romine filed against Elizabeth P. Romine for desertion then she came back with an answer (if anyone ties in with this family and wants the petition typed up let me know). Then it has a page showing Thomas Romine being on the jury and described as being a good and lawful man. SON OF THOMAS PRICE ROMINE James F. Romine married Mary Ann Wideman on March 3, 1853 Jefferson County, Missouri Their children were: James Thomas Romine born January 20, 1862 in Jefferson County, MO married May A. Wideman on March 6, 1882. James Thomas and May Romine's children were: Frankie Romine born January 05, 1884 in Jefferson County, MO George Thomas Romine born January 27, 1885 in Jefferson County, MO Annie Romine born October 10, 1886 in Jefferson County, MO Estell Romine born December 18, 1887 in Jefferson County, MO Nora H. Romine born February 02, 1889 in Jefferson County, MO Mrs. Mary Ann Romine widow of James F. Romine married Thomas Prather on April 03, 1891 in Jefferson County, MO.
