Hi Fred and Lonnie,

Boy have you guys hit hard on my line today. Here's what I know and what I speculate as well, maybe this will help or maybe you can shed some light my way.

Quimby Romine was my gggGrandfather. He was born apx. 1812 in Kentucky.

I do not know what county but suspect somewhere around Shelby. Quimby may have been the son of William(Sr.) Romine. It is my belief that William (Sr.) had a brother named Samuel. William (Sr.) Romine married Susanna Jeffrie in Jefferson County, Ky Nov 25, 1809. Samuel Romine married Patsy Jeffris Sept. 7, 1815 in Nelson County, KY. I believe the two were brothers and they married sisters. William first shows up in the census records in 1810 in Shelby Co. Ky with just him and a female in the same age group. This would be Susanna since they were married in 1809. Samuel first shows up in 1820 with 1 female 16-26 (Patsy) and 1 female under 10 and 1 male under 10. William shows up next in Clark Co. IN in 1820, but then in 1830, Samuel and William show up in Orange Co. IN. In 1840 they both show up in Vigo Co. IN. In the 1840 census records there is a C. Romine that I believe should have been a Q. and was actually Quimby, since the children match what I have on Quimby, and a Wm. Romine and a Sam Romine. William (Sr.) is also on the 1840 census just in a different part of the county. Quimby and William Fielding were probably brothers. William Fielding is the one who married Clarrissa (Ceerecy) Miller second on 3-10-1849. William Fielding had two sons from his first marriage with Sarah Paddock, Ebenezer and James. Ebenezer was killed in action 12-15-1864. This is what I currently have as William Fielding and Clarrisa's

children, please correct if wrong : Sarah b. 1852 Indiana William b. 1854 Indiana Mary b. 1856 Indiana Elija (Eliza) (f) b. 1857 Indiana Ann b. 1859 Indiana Morgan b. 1860 Indiana Susannah b. ? Ida Lillie

Sarah married Hamilton Taylor 10-29-1874 Susannah married Blufred S. Welsh 1-19-1889 Ann married Robert Frakes 12-11-1879 My notes show that William Fielding died in 1875 and Clarrisa died 12-2-1914.

Here's the fun part.

Quimby married Barbary Ellis 3-12-1835. Their children were: Martha Romine b. 12-6-1835 d. 10-25-1853 William Henry Romine b. 1841 d. 1-3-1916 married Nancy C. Bayless Harrison Romine b. 1-15-1845 d. 1-8-1901 married Rachel C. Ping John Romine b. 1848 married Amanda J. Griggs James W. Romine b. 1854 married Tilley Murray

William Henry and Harrison both served in Civil War. I have both records on them.

Interesting that both William Fielding and Quimby both named one of their sons William Henry.

Is there any way Fred that your connection in Famersburg know who William Sr.'s siblings are. If they could possibly confirm that Quimby is indeed a son of William Sr.'s

Lonnie - one note of interest you may not be aware of, Barbary Ellis is from W. VA, so Quimby and family had to have some connections there. I don't know what county she was from yet. One of these days we will close this circle!!!! Hope your doing fine. Haven't talked to you in a while.

Fred, I would love any info you could give me and I'll be more than happy to share more with you!!
