He isn't closely related anyway.

Washington Romine is one of my ancestors. He and his brothers came to Fulton Co circa 1839/1840. Washington died in Fulton Co in 1848 and by 1850 all of his brothers had left the County and moved to either Coles (later Douglas) Co, IL or to Knox Co, IL (Levi B.).

Noah is the son of Isaac Romine and they appear to have come into Fulton Co, IL at just about the time that the other group of Romine's were leaving the area.

There is one exception to this. Washington's wife, Catherine died in about 1838 (either in OH or in Fulton Co--probably Ohio) and Washington remarried, to the widow Margaret Dyer. They had one son named Samuel born a few years before Washington's death. When he died, Margaret kept Samuel with her but she already had a rather large family from her first marriage and the older children of Washington went to live with their uncle, Elias Tiffon Romine, and their grandfather, Lawrence Foster, both of whom are in Coles Co. by the time of the 1880 Census. In fact, the Fosters appear never to have lived in Fulton at all.
