"Jannetje" Bogaert (Bogart) in Hackensack. Jan first lived on his father's farm in

Hackensack. It may be this Jan Romeyn that bought 600 acres of land at "The Ponds" now

Oakland, NJ. They had eleven children:

- 1.) Rachel Romeyn m. (1.) Joris Van Giesen and (2.) Berdan
- 2.) Claes Romeyn was born in 1699 and Bapt. on Feb. 25, 1700 in Hackensack, he died

March 10, 1763. He married (1) Elizabeth Outwater on May 20, 1726 and (2) Rachel

Vreeland(t) on April 14, 1733. He had six children, three with each wife.

- 3.) Jan Janse Romeyn was the great grandfather of Lambert Romain.
- 4.) Stintie "Christina" Romeyn was born in 1705 in Hackensack, she married David Barden and died young.
- 5.) Rolof Romeyn was born in 1708 in Hackensack, he died in 1771 at "The Ponds." He

married Annetjen "Anna" Vreeland on Nov. 02, 1733 in Hackensack. They had three

children.

- 6.) Urseltje "Ursula" Romeyn was born about 1709, she married Isack A. Van Voorhees on
  - Oct. 06, 1731 in Hackensack. (Marriage date may have been Oct. 16, 1731, or

Nov. 26, 1731.)

7.) Theodore Romeyn was born in 1710 in Hackensack. He married Margarietje De Baene in  $$^{7}\,$ 

June, 1728.

8.) David Romeyn was born in 1714 in Hackensack, he probably died in Fishkill, NY. He

married Angnietjen Westervelt on July 02, 1736 in Hackensack. (June 5, 1736 is also

given as a marriage date.) They had seven children.

9.) Isack Romeyn was born in 1716 in Hackensack. He married (1) Zarah (Sarah)? Van

Benschoten and (2) Orseltie Casparus Westervelt on Sept. 15, 1738 in Hackensack.

He had four children, two by each wife. He is listed as a Lt. of Militia in Poughkeepsie, NY in 1769.

- 10) Angenitje Romeyn was born in 1718 in Hackensack. She married Isaac Stagg on Sept.
  - 14, 1738 in Hackensack. They had six children.
- 11) Crisyina "Christina" Romeyn was born in after 1718, she married Abraham Vreeland

on may 24, 1744 in Hackensack.
