This day came the Plaintiff by her Attorney, and it appearing by the oath of a Witness that the Defendants have had legal notice of this motion, they were solemnly called but came not.

Therefore it is considered by the County that the Plaintiff recover against the Defendants one hundred and seventy one dollars and ten-cents, the Penalty of the said bond, and her costs by her in this behalf expended, and the said Defendants in Mercy.

But this Judgment is to be discharged by the payment of Eighty five dollars and fifty five cents, with interest thereon to be computed after the rate of six per centum per annum from the 21st day of January 1836 till payment & the costs.
