> Hi Steve,  
> Picked up your message that Gwen forwarded to the list the  
> other  
> day and am greatly interested in your Romine line, although it isn't  
> mine.  
>  
> > My name is Steve Romines, I live in central Oregon and am at work  
> right  
> > now, up in Prudhoe Bay, Alaska (I work a 2 week on/2 week off  
> schedule,  
> > and will be leaving tomorrow to head home).  
> Where in Central Oregon? I have a brother in Bend...  
>  
> > My dad's (dad just turned 68 today) grandfather, George Washington  
> > Romines (his wife's name was Pauli), recieved a pension from the  
> Union  
> > Army because his father was a Union soldier on the Confederate ship  
> > "Malanta" when it blew up and sank, the same day that Abraham Licoln  
> was  
> > shot. My grandfather's (Ralph Romines) family - George,Pauli, Ralph  
> and  
> > brothers and sisters moved from Sevierville (sp?) Tenn. to Florida  
> when  
> > Grandpa was about 5 years old.  
> By the time that you get this, this will probably be old news  
> but  
> just in case...  
> I think that I have found the family that you are looking for.  
> According to Mildred McDonnell's Romine Book II, you will need to  
>  
> write to the National Archives to get the following pension claim  
> numbers: Wid[ow]105522, 75197; Minor 193931, 150385 as they may have  
> additional information or McDonnell may have made some errors.  
> However, your George Washington Romine seems to have been born  
> 13  
> April 1864. His father was John Romines who mustered into I 3 Tenn.  
> Cav. on Dec 14 1863 at Nashville, TN having enrolled 20 Sept 1863 in  
> Sevrville for three years. At the time John was 30 years old. He  
> died  
> in the explosion on the steamer Sultana. His wife was Rebecca J.  
> Newman  
> and they were married 26 July 1857 in Sevier Co. Other children named  
>  
> in the claim were Sarah E born 23 June 1858, and Emeline, born 11 May  
> 1862. On 28 May 1869, Rebecca married Mark Robertson.  
> According to the pension claim, on 2 Aug 1869, W. C. Murphy was  
> appointed Guardian of the children. William Campbell Murphy made  
> application in Sevier Co. Court for pensions for his wards, and the

> same  
> day George W. Romines of Sevierville appeared and stated "...he has a  
> natural sympathy for the wards, who are his GRANDCHILDREN."  
>  
> The above John Romines was one of four Romines who died in that  
> explosion. The others were David R. Romines, Laten Romines and Samuel  
>  
> L.[or I.] Romines. Samuel mustered into the same unit as John on the  
> same date, having enrolled 9 Sept 1863 in Sevierville and was also from  
>  
> the Sevier Co, TN area. Laten also mustered into the same unit as  
> John  
> on the same date and had enrolled on the same date. His mother was  
> Zuba  
> Romines and she applied for a widowed mother's claim (#184493, 146843)  
>  
> stating that her husband, Thomas, had died two years previous [to what  
>  
> date is not clear] and that she had been supported by Laten until his  
> death. I have found no information on David R. Romines yet.  
> I don't know yet if these other fellows are directly related to  
> your John but at least it gives you something to work with.  
>
