I also think that the place is probably wrong. What I have from a history of Fountain Co says that after eight years of marriage, Isaac and Elizabeth moved first to Warren Co, OH and then to Fountain Co, IN. Elizabeth, in her pension claim, states that she came to Fountain Co in 1832.

However, their oldest son is named Smith Romine and his oldest two children were born in Preston Co, VA now WV in 1832 and 1833. Smith's third child was born in IN. Elizabeth's father, Samuel Crane, died in Preston, VA in 1821.

I don't know anything about Smith's wife, Gainor Forman. But, unless she was also from VA and got homesick and demanded to return to VA, I would imagine that the family was still in VA at least until Smith was married... I suppose that Smith and his family may have shifted back and forth between the two states.

Anyway, there are hints that they were from the area of VA which is now WV.
