NO ROMINE, ROMAINE, ROMEYN, etc. However there was one name that may have been a misread/miscopy for Romain as it is the only occurrence of the spelling.

p. 95 William B. Norris, apprentice to Gabriel Van Buskirk, complains. People's witnesses: Wm. B. Norris, Abraham Romaine, James Norris, Abraham Mabie. Defendant's witness: John Stevens. Apprentice is discharged. 5 Oct 1804.
