Chanc'y Order Book, Sup. Court, Book No. 1, p 146, Frederick Co VA:

(13 April 1813)

PETER ROMINE.....appellant

against

SAMUEL BUTCHER.....appellec,

upon an appeal from a decree of the County Court of Loudoun, recovered by the appellec against the appellant & others the 13th day of April of 1813, whereby it was adjudged that the report of Commissions made in persuance of an interlocutory decree of said Court made the 14th day of January 1813: be confirmed and that the Complt recover of the Defendants his costs in said suit appealed.

This day came the parties by their counsel, whereupon the transcript of the record of the source aforesaid being seen and inspected, and the Court having heard the arguments of Counsel, and maturely considered the same is of opinion that the said decree is erroneous. Therefore it is adjudged, ordered and decreed that the same be reversed and annulled, and that the appellant recover against the appellee his costs by him appended in the prosecution of his appeal aforesaid here.

And it is further adjudged, ordered and decreed that the Bale of the plaintiff be dismissed, and that the defendant ROMINE recover against the said plaintiff his costs by him about his defense in the said County Court expended. But this dismission is to be without prejudice to the plaintiff, who has liberty to commence his suit again.

On the petition of PETER ROMINE, & for good cause shown, an appeal is allowed him from a decree of the County Court of Loudoun, recovered by SAMUEL BUTCHER against the said Peter Romine & others the 13th day of April 1813, upon the said Peter Romine, entering into bond with sufficient security in the office of this Court in the penalty of one hundred dollars conditioned as the Law directs: and the Court doth also award a supercedias (upon said bond being given) to stay all further proceedings upon the said decree.
