Frm the bit of information that I have, I don't think that it could be. That Isaac was probably born about 1750-1760. In the early 1800's Peter Romine Jr was sued by the widow of his brother John and all f her children as well as Joseph West, his brother-in-law, in order to force the division of the property of Peter Sr which had been willed to Isaac but was still being held by Peter Jr as no one had heard from Isaac since he went off to fight in the Rev War. There would appear to have been enough Romines in the area of Harrison Co that if this had been that Isaac, those back in Loudoun Co would have known it.

It is much more likely that the fellow married in 1808 will turn out to be a son of Peter Jr. So far, however, I have found no indications that he had a son of that name.
